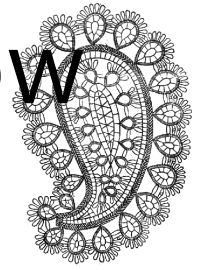

Fat Steer Show Rules and Information

Florida Fat Steer Entry Fee: \$100.00 entry postmarked by **October 30, 2010**. Late entries will be accepted **November 15, 2010** with an additional fee of **\$50.00** per exhibitor. Only one steer may be entered per exhibitor. Steers will not have to be slaughtered, and there will not be a sale. Steers intended for other terminal shows may be entered. Showmanship will be \$10.00 per exhibitor, and will compete along with prospect heifer exhibitors.

NEW: Steers entered in this show must have an EID bolus inserted (electronic identification). Show locations to be released soon (one is August, September and October). There will be a \$15.00 fine for the bolus to be paid when the steer is identified. This will complete the entry. The same steer entered at the initial entry/bolus must be the steer shown at the Florida Fat Steer Show in January, and will be verified by the EID. If you have any questions concerning the bolus, please call any time.

Awards: We will be placing the top 5 steers overall with Grand Champion Steer receiving \$3500.00, Reserve Grand Champion Steer receiving \$2500.00, and cash prizes for 3rd, 4th, and 5th. Grand and Reserve Champion Steers will also receive a trophy. Class payout will be for top 3 in each class.

Rules:

- Exhibitors must be a member of 4-H, FFA, Florida Junior Cattlemen's Association or a breed association, up to the age of 21. **ALL EXHIBITORS MUST BE A FLORIDA RESIDENT.**
- NO GENERATORS are allowed inside the barn for any reason.
- Steers cannot be over 24 months of age.
- Health certificates on all livestock will be required during check-in.
- Exhibitors should be dressed neatly with long jeans and boots required.
- Neck ties are required overnight.
- Committee members reserve the right to disqualify exhibitors due to safety issues if needed.
- This is a steer show intended for terminal fat steers, and will be judged as such. Steers should weigh a minimum of 1000 pounds at check in on January 14, 2011.

Heifer Classic Show Rules and Information

Heifer Classic Entry Fee: \$25.00 for first heifer, \$15 per head each additional heifer, postmarked by **January 4, 2011**. There will be a late fee of \$10.00 per head at the show. No maximum number of entries per exhibitor. Entries will be accepted day of show (cash only). Showmanship will be \$10.00 per exhibitor.

Rules:

- Exhibitors must be a member of 4-H, FFA, Florida Junior Cattlemen's Association or a breed association, up to the age of 21.
- NO GENERATORS are allowed inside the barn for any reason.
- Cattle may be shown as long as they are 3 years of age or younger.
- Health certificates on all livestock will be required during check-in.
- Exhibitors should be dressed neatly with long jeans and boots required.
- Neck ties are required overnight.
